

The following are the rules and regulations that will be used throughout the tournament. If you have any questions pertaining to the rules, they must be addressed at the Wednesday seeding meeting. **NO RULES** will be addressed the day of the tournament.

Rules and Regulations

1. Pits will be 40 feet in length with a foul line at the front edge of the pit.
2. Stakes will be 12 inches from the ground leaning slightly toward each other.
3. Coin flip determines who shoots first and also choice of shoes.
4. All games will be played best of three, to 15 points, win by two. However, first to 21 points wins.
5. Only the final round, championship game will be **best of three** played to **21 points**.
6. Plaques will be presented to top 3 places.

Scoring

1. Closest to the pin, 1 point.

NOTE: All measured points must be within the width of the open end of the shoe to count.

2. Ringer 3 points. All ringers are 3 points cumulative.

EXAMPLE: A topped ringer is 6 points, 3 ringers 9 points, etc.

3. A leaner counts as 1 point. Any opponent's shoe touching the pin cancels the point.

NOTE: A leaner is no more than a shoe on its side.

Sportsmanship

You are an invited guest to this event, which is strictly for fun. Please be mature enough to police your own behavior. Don't put yourself or others in an embarrassing situation. Think before you act and ask yourself this question, "Do I want to be invited back?"
